### **Scope of unpaid internship**

You will help monitor and respond to legislative actions, as well as help plan, coordinate, and execute efforts to support or oppose bills. Your efforts will help to shape the future of our state, and influence the rest of our nation.

### **Requirements:**

Excellent internet, word processing and spreadsheet skills (Microsoft Office).

Strong organizational skills

Capable of attending phone/online meetings

Effective writing and communication skills

Conduct research on state bills and develop reports

Travel with either FL NOW Legislative Director, President, or Lobbyist desirable but not required, transportation and temporary housing may be provided when needed.

Able to attend Florida Legislative Session or committee meetings in Tallahassee a plus

Must be willing to work with NOW's Coalition Partners: ACLU, Planned Parenthood, Human Rights Watch, Progress Florida, Equality Florida, Florida Immigrant and other progressive organizations.
